

2009 ATLANTA ASSOCIATION OF INSURANCE PROFESSIONALS' SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Atlanta Association of Insurance Professionals' Scholarship Award

The Scholarship Award was established in 1990 for outstanding high school and/or college students. The annual award is conducted by AAIP, which is a non-profit organization comprised of professionals in the insurance industry organized to promote the professional growth of its members. The annual award is now known as the T. M. Alexander Annual Scholarship Award.

Who is eligible?

College Students

Any college undergraduate student is eligible if he/she:

1. Will be enrolled as a full-time student in a risk-management/insurance-related (business management, marketing, finance, or accounting) program at an accredited four-year college/university during the 2009-2010 school year;
2. Has completed one or more years of school in an accredited four-year college/university
3. Has a minimum overall G.P.A. of 2.6;
4. Is a U.S. Citizen;
5. Currently resides in the metropolitan Atlanta or attends a college/university in the metropolitan Atlanta area;
6. Has not previously received a College Scholarship from AAIP.

How does a student apply for the Scholarship?

College Students

A college undergraduate student must submit a completed application package including the following documents:

1. Essay;
2. Official college transcript;
3. College entry form;
4. Letter of recommendation from a college professor:

All applicants are also required to participate in a telephone or face-to-face interview by May 8, 2009.

How are winners selected?

Winners will be selected from a group of candidates who meet the eligibility requirements. AAIP will select the winner(s) by evaluating each candidate's academic record, significant activities and contributions to the school and community, letters of recommendations, biographical sketch or resume and essay. Winners will be notified by June 8, 2009. All winners will be notified prior to any public announcement.

What is the amount of the award?

AAIP will award a total of (TBA) in scholarship money. However, AAIP reserves the right to award the money to a single outstanding applicant or to divide the money among as many as four applicants. Winners get a free AAIP membership

Are there terms and conditions that scholarship winners must meet?

Yes. In addition to the eligibility requirements, **all winners must attend AAIP's Scholarship Banquet**, which will occur on a date that will be announced later.

Winners must also:

- Attend AAIP meetings regularly
- Actively participate with the organization
- Send a progress report to update AAIP on how they are doing
